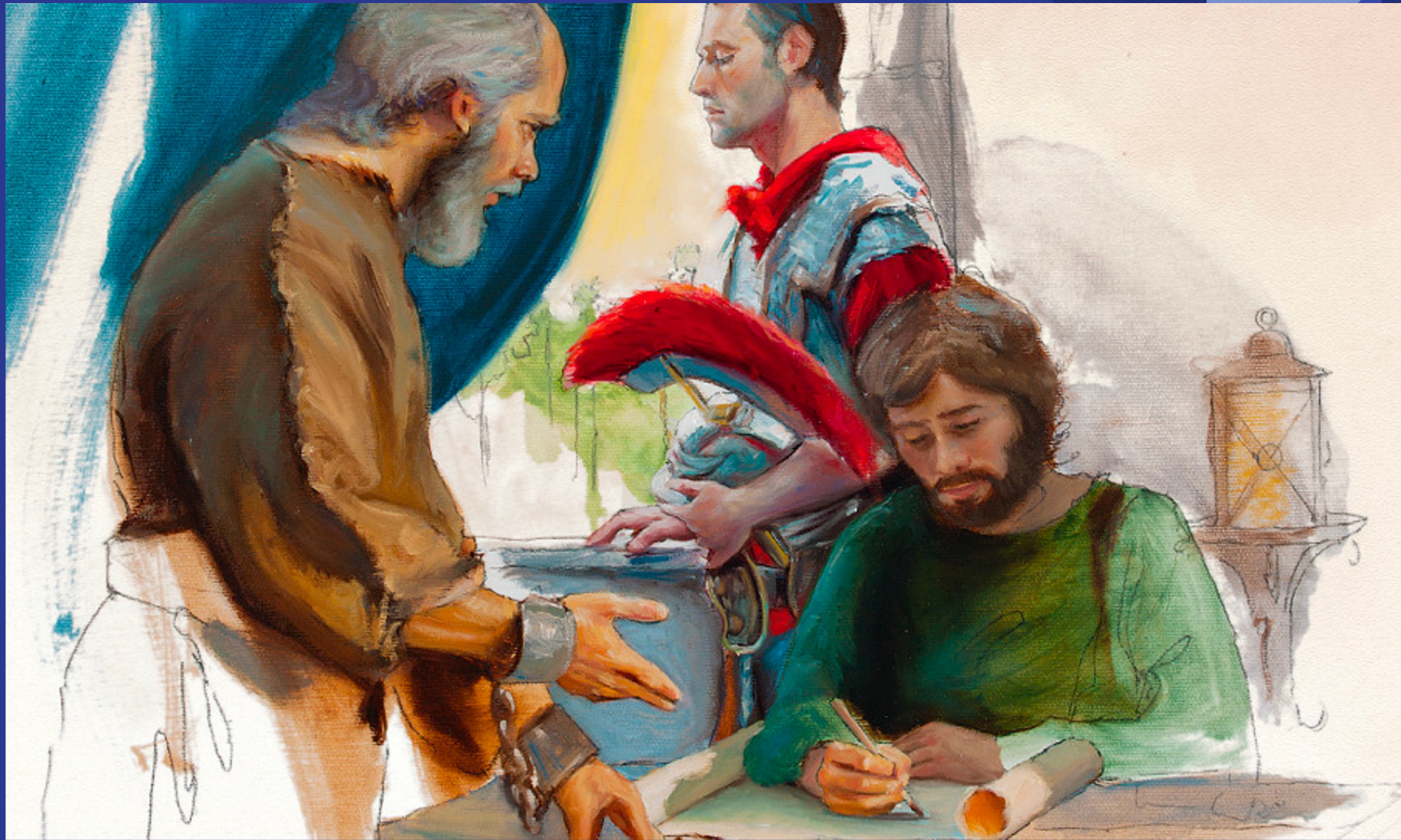


Act 28:16
