

#### Genesis 9


8 Then God said to Noah and to his sons with him, 9 "Behold, I establish my covenant with you and your offspring after you, 10 and with every living creature that is with you, the birds, the livestock, and every beast of the earth with you, as many as came out of the ark; it is for every beast of the earth. 11 I establish my covenant with you, that never again shall all flesh be cut off by the waters of the flood, and never again shall there be a flood to destroy the earth."

12 And God said, "This is the sign of the covenant that I make between me and you and every living creature that is with you, for all future generations: 13 I have set my bow in the cloud, and it shall be a sign of the covenant between me and the earth. 14 When I bring clouds over the earth and the bow is seen in the clouds, 15 I will remember my covenant that is between me and you and every living creature of all flesh.

And the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all flesh. **16** When the bow is in the clouds, I will see it and remember the everlasting covenant between God and every living creature of all flesh that is on the earth." **17** God said to Noah, "This is the sign of the covenant that I have established between me and all flesh that is on the earth."




Genesis 41:57 – all the earth came to Egypt to Joseph to buy grain, because the famine was severe over all the earth

creation (lit: 'to every creature')

Acts 2:5 – in Jerusalem ... devout men from every nation under heaven

Francis Schaeffer; 'degrees of freedom' in biblical interpretation

- The Bible, both the OT and the NT, is complicated.
- There is a huge amount of misunderstanding about the Bible.
- The amount of misunderstanding and ignorance of the Bible in America is increasing dramatically every day and this matters because understanding the Bible is vital to The Christian Faith.
- Healthy spiritual growth depends upon understanding the Bible: that
  means if you want to remain healthy, especially as you age, you need
  to go deeper into the Bible. Right now we are merely scratching the
  surface.



•Genesis 7-11: Flood + Noah → Babel → Abram

- barren/can't have kids although they've tried: Sarai Gn 11:30; Rebecca Gn 25:21
- sibling rivalry: Abram and Lot (Gn 13); Isaac and Ishmael (21:8ff); Isaac's sons Jacob and Esau (Gn 25:22 etc)
- compromise over wife's beauty (fear): Abram in Egypt Gn 12, and w Abimelech Gn 20; Isaac Gn 26
- covenant w Abimelech: Abraham Gn 21:27; Isaac Gn 26:28



- Choosing a life of FAITH in the midst of human vanity.
- Gn 11:28, 31, departure from Ur = faith leaving a society that is becoming increasingly godless.
- 31They went up from Ur of the Chaldeans to go into the land of Canaan, but when they came to Haran they settled there ...
- 12:1Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you...
- 4 So Abram went ... Abram was seventy five years old when he departed from Haran.

- Neh 9:7 You are the LORD, the God who chose Abram and brought him up from Ur of the Chaldeans and gave him the name Abraham
- Act 7:2-4 The God of glory appeared to our father Abraham when he was in Mesopotamia, before he lived in Haran, and said to him, "Go out from your land and from your kindred and go into the land that I will show you." Then he went out from the land of the Chaldeans and lived in Haran...
- Haran Gen 12:4-5 temporary residence in the bigger picture.
