For in my wrath I struck you – but in my favor I have mercy on you.
Your gates shall be open continually; day and night they shall not shut
That people may bring to you the wealth of the nations,
With their kings led in procession.

Isaiah 60:12

For the nation and the kingdom
That will not serve you shall perish
Those nations shall be utterly laid waste

Isaiah 60:13-14

The glory of Lebanon shall come to you, the cypress the plane and the pine,

To beautify the place of my sanctuary, and I will make the place of my feet glorious.

The sons of those who afflicted you shall come bending low to you, And all who despised you shall bow at your feet;

They shall call you the City of the LORD, the Zion of the Holy One of Israel.

Instead of wood, bronze, and instead of stones, iron.

I will make your overseers peace and your taskmasters
righteousness;

Violence shall no more be heard in your land, devastation or
destruction within your borders;

You shall call your walls Salvation, and your gates, Praise.

The sun shall be no more your light by day, nor for brightness shall the moon give you light;

But the LORD will be your everlasting light, and your God will be your glory.

Your sun shall no more go down, nor your moon withdraw itself; For the LORD will be your everlasting light, and your days of mourning shall be ended.

The branch of my planting, the work of my hands, that I might be glorified.

The least one shall become a clan, and the smallest one a mighty nation;

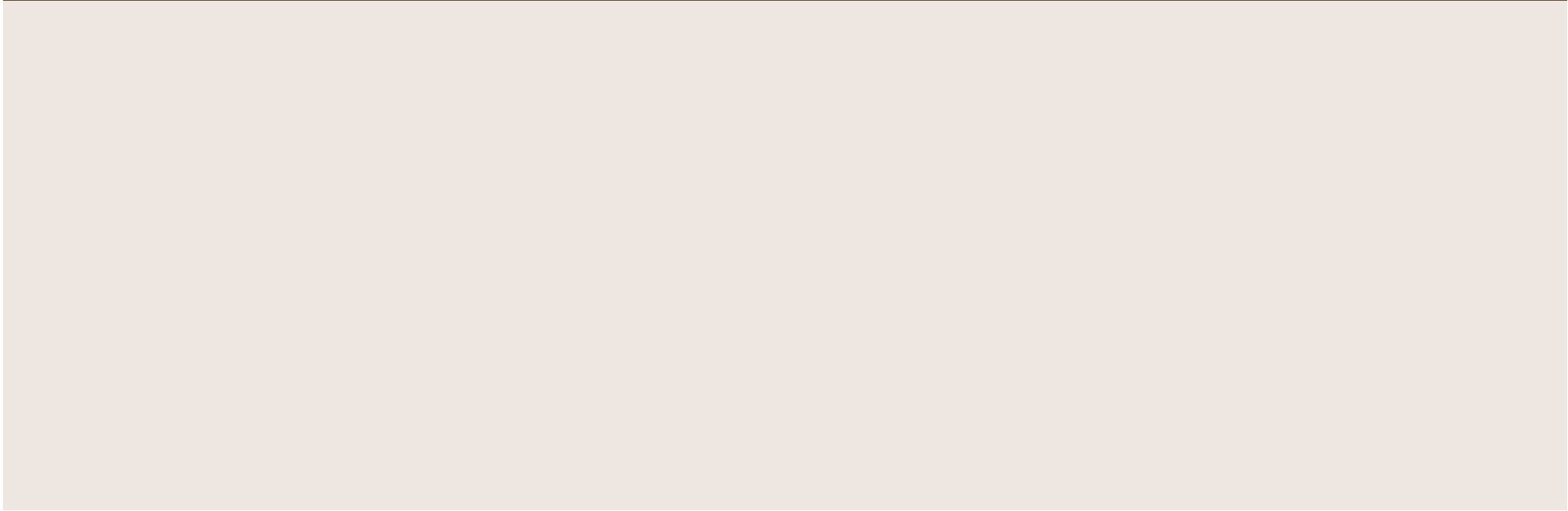
