will be blessed through you.”

Hebrew Words and Sayings, Names of God

YHWH = Yahweh/ Jehovah, the name of God. Pronunciation unknown due to the holiness of HaShem

HaShem = the Name; One’s Name = the reputation of that Person
(do not take The Name in vain)

“Shalom aleichem” = Peace be upon you; reply: “Aleichem shalom”

Adonai = Lord

El = God, usually as strong or great; Elohim = God plural, indicating intensity; because YHWH is God of Gods and three in One, we can say ‘Elohim’ (see Deut 10:17)

El Shaddai = God Almighty (Gn 17:1)
