


Isaiah 39:1-2

At that time Merodach-baladan the son of Baladan, king of Babylon, sent envoys with letters and a present to Hezekiah, for he had heard that he had been sick and had recovered. And Hezekiah welcomed them gladly and showed them his treasure house, the silver, the gold, the spices, the precious oil, his whole armory

Isaiah 39:3-4

Then Isaiah the prophet came to King Hezekiah and said to him, "What did these men say? And from what country did they come to you? Hezekiah said, "They have come from a far country, from Babylon." He said, "What have they seen in your house?" Hezekiah answered, "They have seen all that is in my house. There is nothing in my storehouses that I did not show them."

Isaiah 39:5-7

Then Isaiah said to Hezekiah, "Hear the word of the LORD of hosts: 'Behold, the days are coming, when all that is in your house, and that which your fathers have stored up till this day, shall be carried to Babylon. 2 Chronicles 29:3

In the first year of his reign ...Hezekiah opened the doors of the house of the LORD and repaired them. He brought in the priests and the Levites and .. said to them ... "consecrate yourselves, and consecrate the house of the LORD the God of our fathers... Our fathers have forsaken Him and turned away their faces and have been unfaithful....

2 Chronicles 30:1, 10-11

Hezekiah sent to all Israel and Judah, and wrote letters also to Ephraim and Manasseh, that they should come to the house of the LORD at Jerusalem to keep the Passover to the LORD, the God of Israel... So the couriers went from city to city through the country of Ephraim and Manasseh, and as far as Zebulun, but they laughed them to scorn and mocked them. However, some men of Asher, of Manasseh, and of Zebulun humbled themselves

2 Chronicles 30:18-20

A majority of the people, many from Ephraim, Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet they ate the Passover ... Hezekiah prayed for them saying, 'May the good LORD pardon everyone who sets his heart to seek the LORD, the God of his fathers, even though not according to the sanctuary's rules of cleanness.' And the LORD heard Hezekiah and healed the people.

2 Chronicles 30:26, 27

So there was great joy in Jerusalem, for since the time of Solomon the son of David King of Israel there had been nothing like this in Jerusalem. Then the priests and the Levites arose and blessed the people, and their voice was heard, and their prayer came to his holy habitation in heaven.



2 Chronicles 31:1

Now when all this was finished, all Israel who were present went out to the cities of Judah and broke in pieces the pillars and cut down the Asherim and broke down the high places and the altars throughout all Judah and Benjamin, and in Ephraim and Manasseh, until they had destroyed them all.

Sennacherib boasts: 2 Chronicles 32:17

'Like the gods of the nations of the lands who have not delivered their people from my hands, so the God of Hezekiah will not deliver his people from my hand.'

Isaiah 37:29

Because you have raged against me and your complacency has come to my ears I will put my hook in your nose and my bit in your mouth, and I will turn you back on the way by which you came.






