Give us each day our daily bread

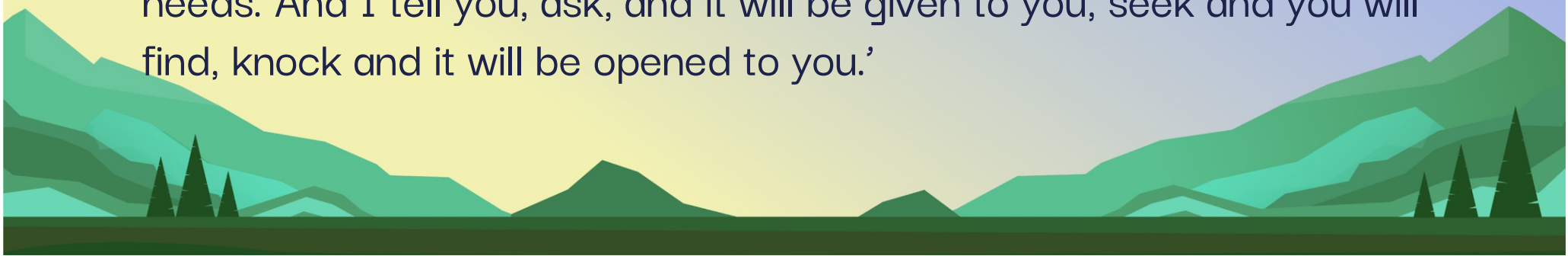
And forgive us our sins, for we forgive everyone who is indebted to us,

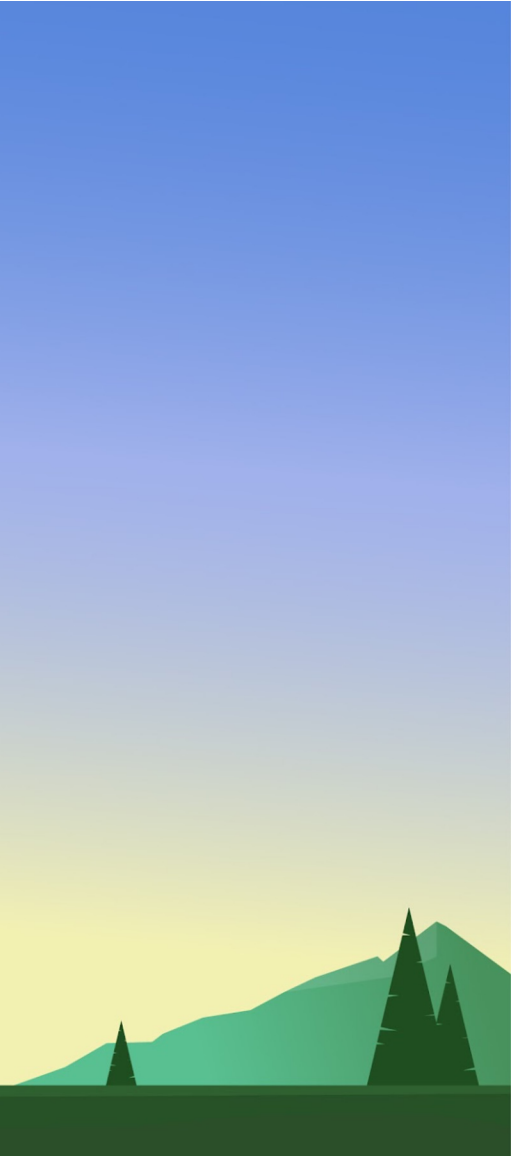
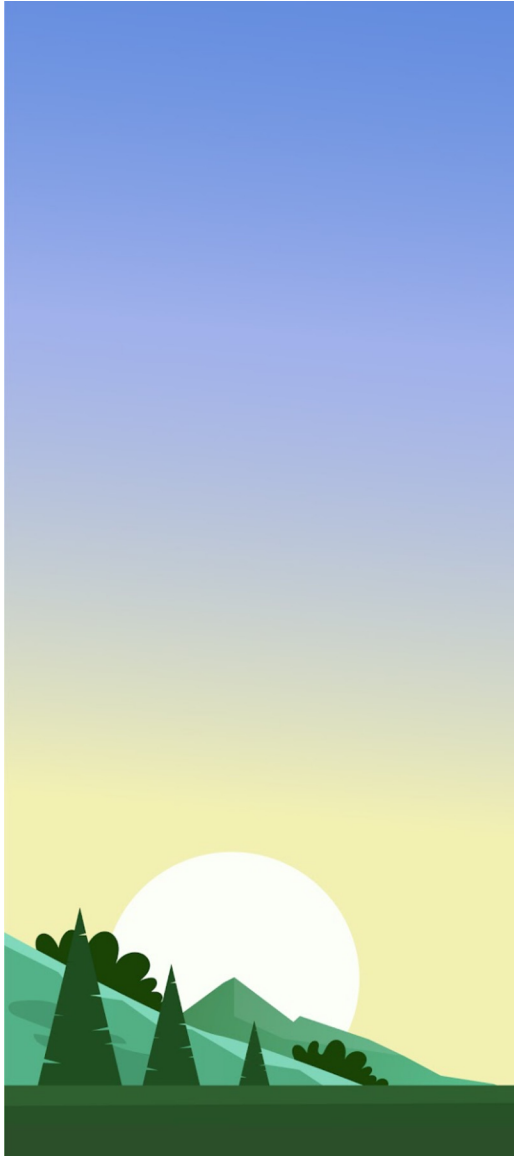
