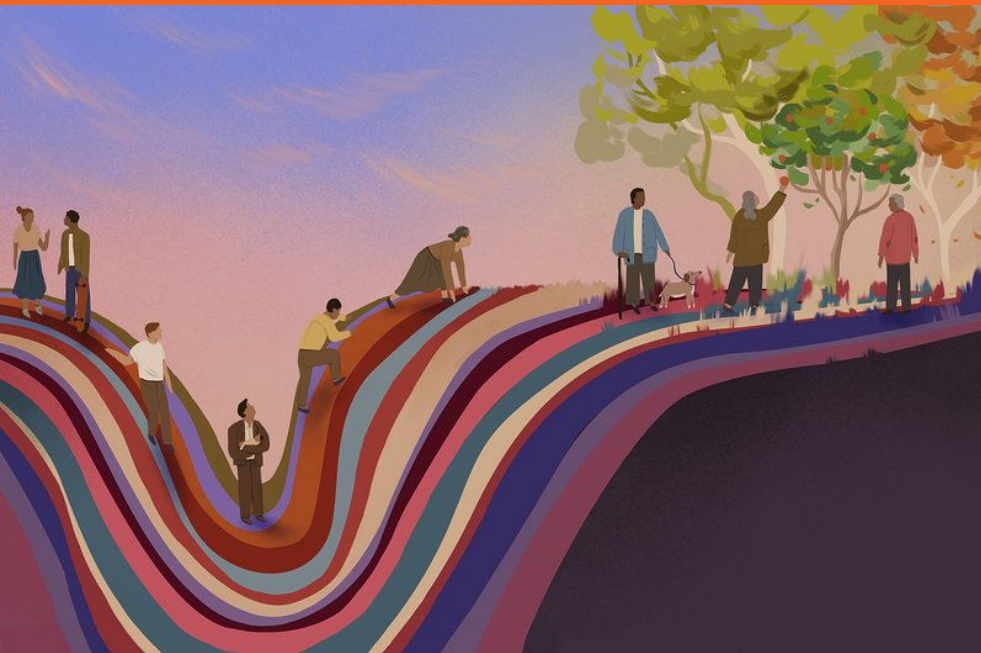


Ecclesiastes 3:2-5

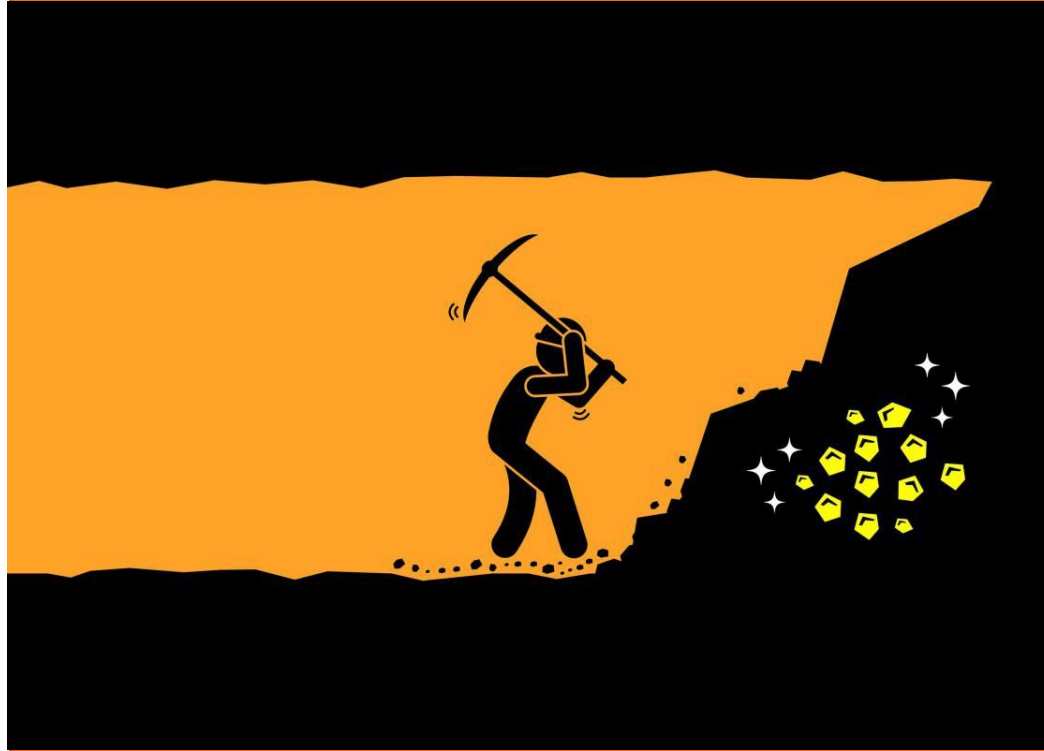
