Colossians 2:12-13 (NCV) - ¹² When you were baptized, you were buried with Christ, and you were raised up with him through your faith in God's power that was shown when he raised Christ from the dead. ¹³ When you were spiritually dead because of your sins and because you were not free from the power of your sinful self, God made you alive with Christ, and he forgave all our sins.

John 5:28-29 (HCSB) - ²⁸ Do not be amazed at this, because a time is coming when all who are in the graves will hear His voice ²⁹ and come out—those who have done good things, to the resurrection of life, but those who have done wicked things, to the resurrection of judgment.

Romans 8:11 (HCSB) - ¹¹ And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, then He who raised Christ from the dead will also bring your mortal bodies to life through His Spirit who lives in you.

To live a godly life and have better relationships, we must ______ the Breath (Spirit) of God.

Galatians 5:16-26 (NIRV) — ¹⁶ So I say, live by the Holy Spirit's power. Then you will not do what your desires controlled by sin want you to do. ¹⁷ The desires controlled by sin do not want what the Spirit delights in. And the Spirit does not want what the desires controlled by sin delight in. The two are at war with each other. That's why you are not supposed to do whatever you want. ¹⁸ But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the authority of the law. ¹⁹ The result of sin's control in our lives is clear. It includes sexual sins, impure acts and wild living. ²⁰ It includes worshiping statues of gods and worshiping evil powers. It also includes hatred and fighting, jealousy and fits of anger. Sinful desire is interested only in getting ahead. It stirs up trouble. It separates people into their own little groups. ²¹ It wants what others have. It gets drunk and takes part in wild parties. It does many things of that kind. I warn you now as I did before. People who live like this will not receive God's kingdom. ²² But the fruit the Holy Spirit produces is love, joy and peace. It is being patient, kind and good. It is being faithful ²³ and gentle and having control of oneself. There is no law against things of that kind. ²⁴ Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed their sinful desires to his cross. They don't want these things anymore. ²⁵ Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit. ²⁶ Let us not become proud. Let us not make each other angry. Let us not want what belongs to others.
